3. A standard hydrant wrench is to be used when opening and closing the hydrant and a gate valve placed on the 2 1/2 inch port of the hydrant. The hydrant will be completely opened and the flow of water regulated with the gate valve. The gate valve is to be removed and the hydrant completely closed at the end of each day.
4. Any damage incurred to hydrant, standpipe and/or appurtenance apparently caused by the permittee's use, in the judgment of the permitting agency, will be charged to the permittee, who agrees to pay all costs or repairs.
